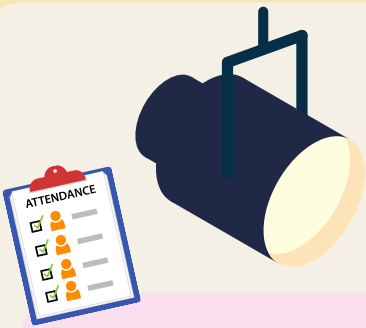


## TEAM TYNDALE

# ATTENDANCE SPOTLIGHT



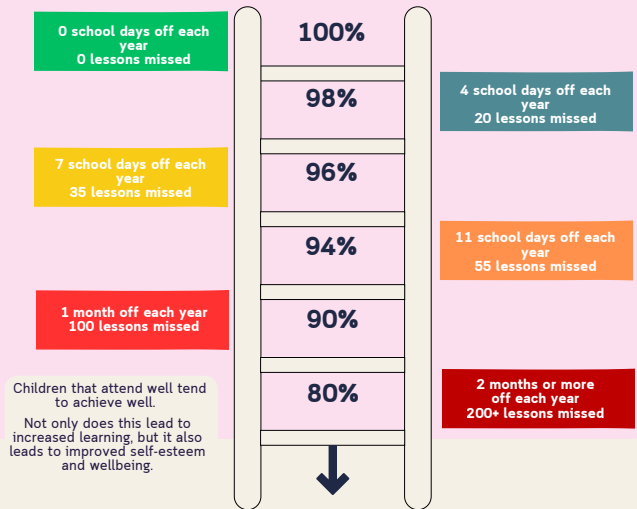
## Absence from School
