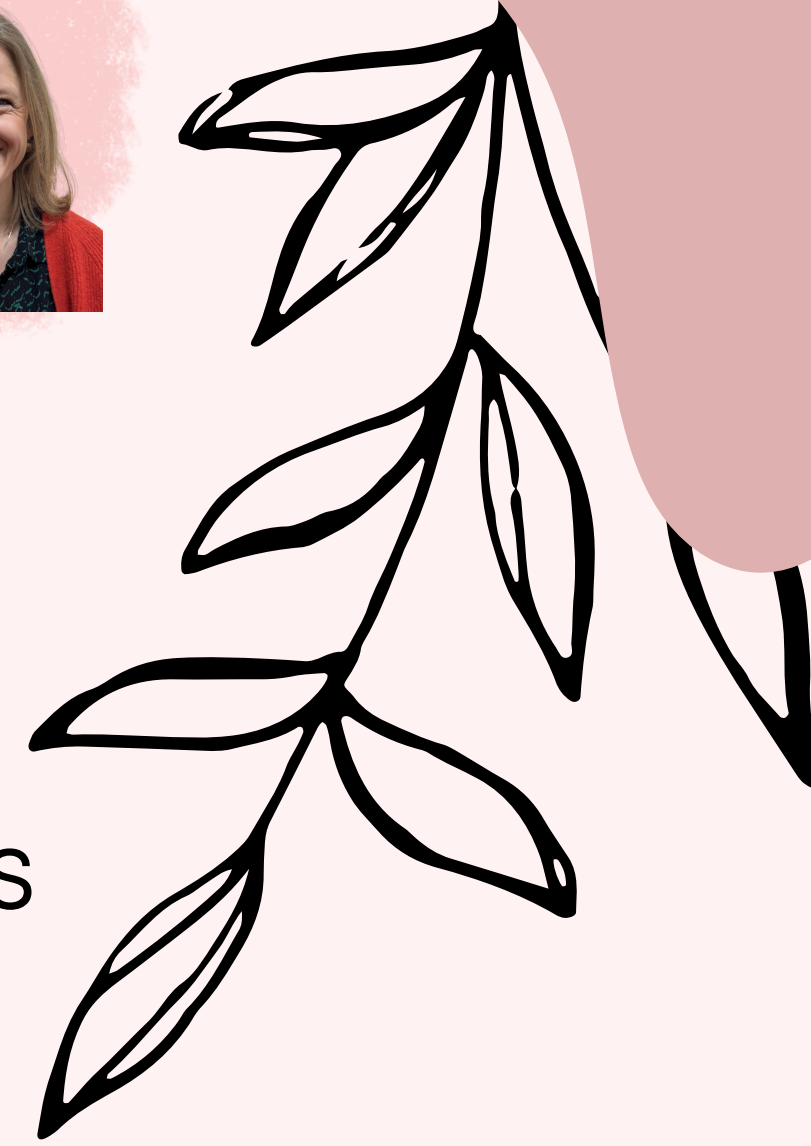

Reporting of Safeguarding for all Staff and Visitors:

- **Immediate** safeguarding concerns **MUST** be disclosed to DSL/DDSL verbally, then put on CPOMS.
- **Non-urgent** concerns **MUST** be logged on CPOMS on your own account.
- If you cannot get on CPOMS, please report concerns via the **PINK FORM** in the Staffroom.



Safeguarding children is the responsibility of all.
