Please ensure you have signed in on the Sign In screen located in the main office.

You will be issued with either a red or rainbow lanyard.

- Red - safeguarding checks complete - safe to be unsupervised
- Rainbow - must be supervised at all times

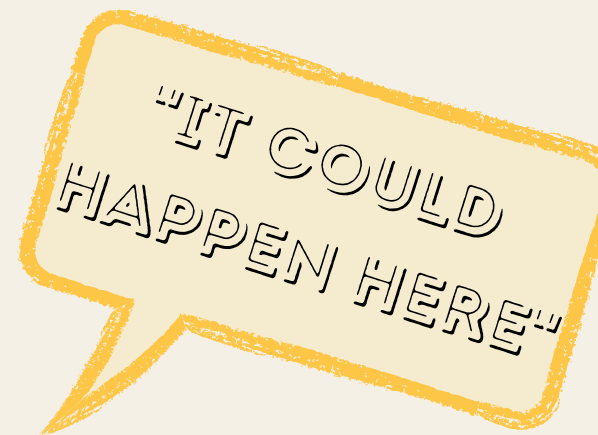
