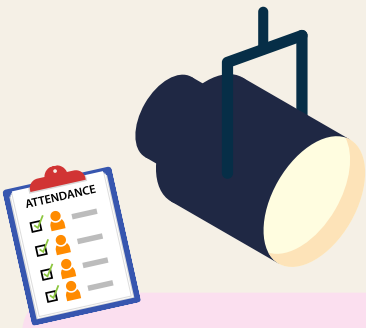

Not only does this lead to increased learning, but it also leads to improved self-esteem and wellbeing.

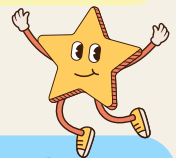


## SEND SPOTLIGHT

## CHARACTER SPOTLIGHT



At Tyndale, one of the key character habits we want every child to develop is being Ready. Being ready means arriving at school prepared, focused and eager to learn so that children can make the most of every opportunity in the classroom. We encourage pupils to develop positive routines that help them start the day successfully. Simple strategies at home, such as packing school bags the night before and having a calm, organised morning routine, can help children arrive at school feeling confident, settled and ready to learn.
