- Well done to our fantastic Year 1 and 2 children who completed the Phonics Screening Check this week!

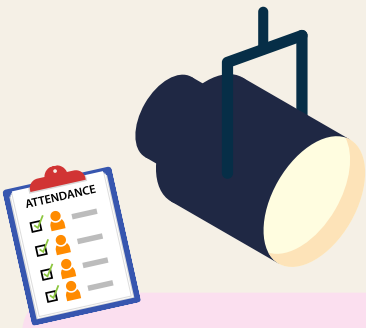

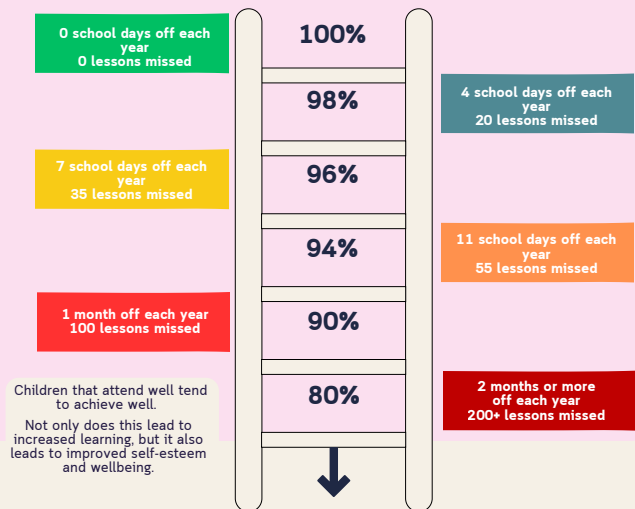
Absence from School

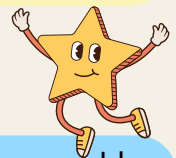


SEND SPOTLIGHT
