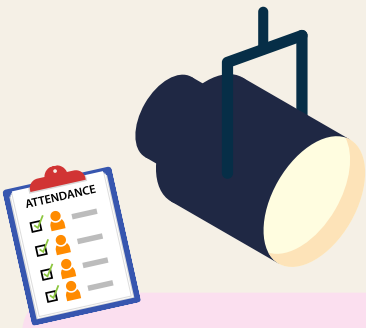

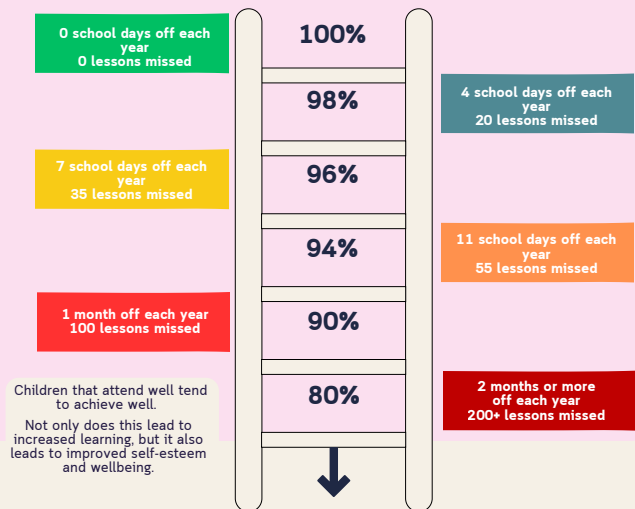
Absence from School
