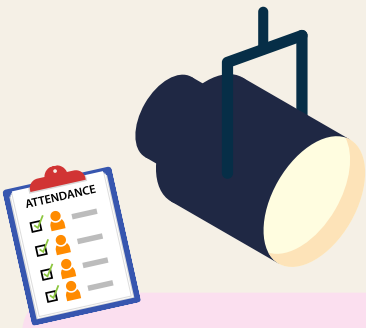

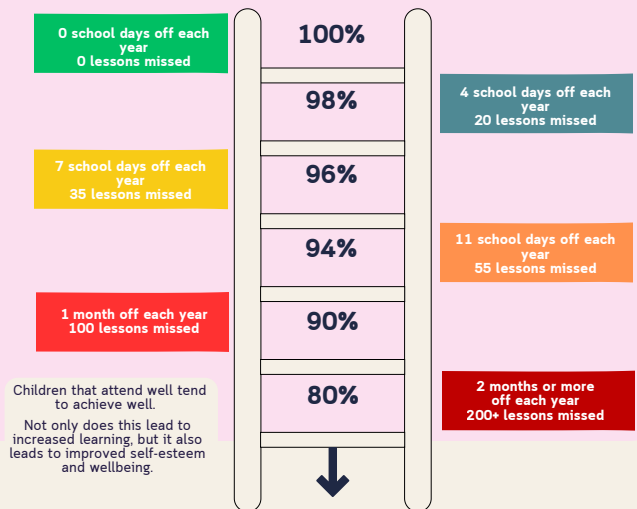
Absence from School

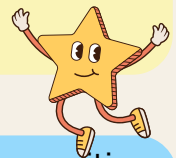


SEND SPOTLIGHT
