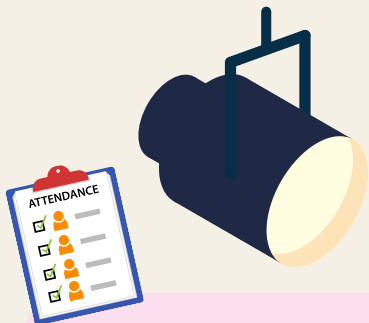

CHARACTER SPOTLIGHT

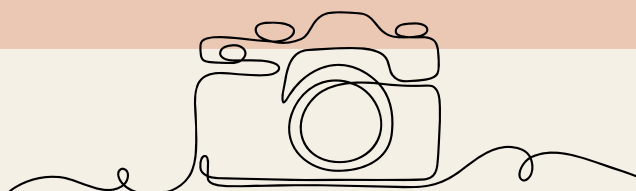
