### **School Reopening on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021**

We are delighted with the recent announcement that our school will be open to all year groups from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021! Please note, that from this date, **attendance for all pupils will be mandatory.**

In order to ensure the safety of all pupils, parents and staff we will be continuing with our staggered start and end to the day. These timings have not changed but are listed below for your reference:

Reception: 8.50am – 3.00pm  
Year 1: 8.40am – 3.10pm  
Year 2: 8.45am – 3.15pm  
Year 3: 8.50am – 3.10pm  
Year 4: 8.45am – 3.10pm  
Year 5: 8.40am – 3.20pm  
Year 6: 8.15am – 3.15pm

The pedestrian one-way system **must be followed by all adults on site** please. The entrance to our school site is from the pedestrian gate on Cranleigh Court Road and leads to the exit, which is beyond the bike shed onto Tyndale Avenue.

It is expected that all adults on school site wear a face covering at all times. If you are exempt from wearing a face covering, please be ready to show your exemption card.

As always, we are regularly reviewing our risk assessments to mitigate the risk of infection as much as possible. There are significant measures in place to achieve this including:

- Segregated bubbles
- Designated bubble areas for break/lunchtime play
- Multiple hand sanitising stations around school and timetabled handwashing opportunities
- High windows and internal doors will remain open throughout the school day
- Limited resources being carried from home to school
  - Lunchboxes can be brought to school and taken home daily
  - PE kits to be brought in on a Monday and taken home to be washed on a Friday
  - Planners and reading books can be taken home and brought to school
  - No other unnecessary items are permitted including pupils' own stationery.
