Perhaps most famously, he is remembered for having six wives.

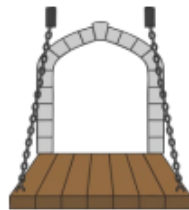

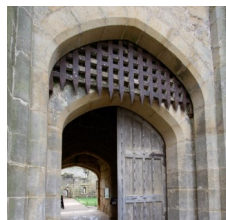

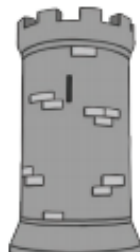
