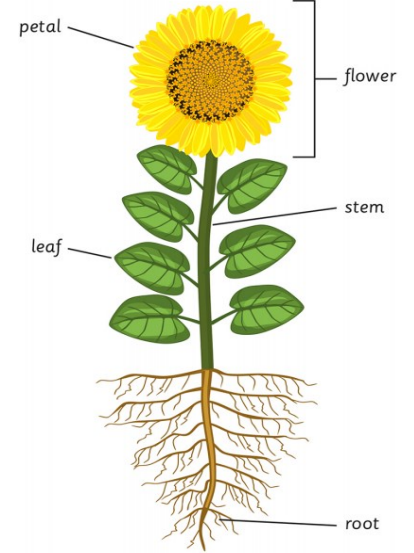

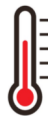

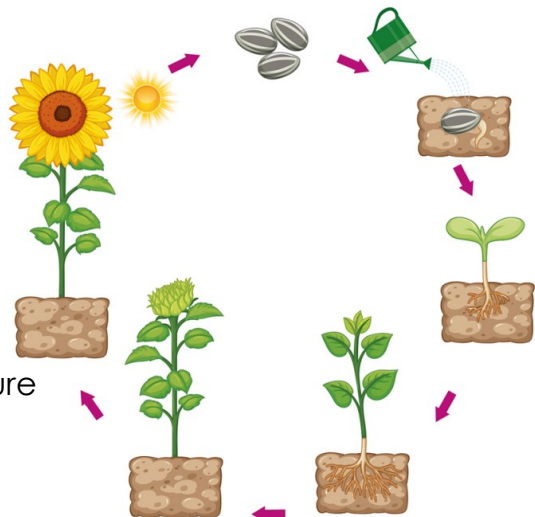

Key Vocabulary

bud	A small growth on a plant that develops into a leaf, flower or new shoot.
flower	Often brightly coloured, produces a pleasant scent to attract insects and creates seeds.
germinate	The growth of a seed into a young plant or a seedling
leaf	Uses sunlight to make food.
nutrient	Substances that help plants and animals live and grow.
petal	Often colourful and makes up most of the flower with other petals.
root	Grows out of the seed and deep into the ground to find water and nutrients.
shoot	Grows upwards out of the seed before it develops into a stem and leaves.
stem	Grows upwards, towards the light. It supports the plant.
