Where do I drop off/pick up my child?

EYFS start at **8.50am** and finish at 3.10pm Years 1 - 6 start at **8.40am** and finish at 3.20pm

NEW All classroom doors will now be open 5 minutes before the start of the school day, this allows all pupils to settle in and be in their seats ready to start learning promptly.

- EYFS Turn left as you enter through the pedestrian gate on Cranleigh Court Road, follow the path around to the KS1 playground. On the far side, it is the red EYFS outdoor area gate.
- Year 1 The first red door as you turn left from the pedestrian entry from Cranleigh Court Road.
- Year 2 The second red door as you turn left from the pedestrian entry from Cranleigh Court Road, and then right onto the KS1 playground.





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- Year 3 The second classroom door as you turn right at the KS2 building, past the bike shed, this is the door closest to the pedestrian gate to Tyndale Avenue (by the nursery).
- Year 4 The second classroom door as you turn left at the KS2 building, on the KS2 playground.
- Year 5 The first classroom door as you turn right at the KS2 building, past the bike shed.
- Year 6 The first classroom door as you turn left at the KS2 building, on the KS2 playground.

<u>Home School Agreement (*NEW*)</u>

As we continue our rapid school improvement journey, we recognise the importance of working in partnership with our families and we require your support with this please. This is because, when schools and parents/carers listen to each other and work in partnership, research has shown that **this has a monumental impact on a child's attainment and their overall well-being**.

Therefore, from September 2023, and each year thereafter, it is a requirement that all parents/carers confirm that they will adhere to our home school agreement which can be read and completed here. Please could you complete this before your child returns to school on Monday 4th September, it will take no longer than 5 minutes. You can just do one on behalf of all of your family provided you list all of the adults and children on the form. The office will contact you in the first week of term should we not have a home school agreement in place.

As always, we appreciate your support and partnership to allow us to give your child the best chance of success.

What does my child need?

- Full school uniform (this means shirts and a tie from Year 1 6, and polo shirts in EYFS), <u>our policy can be</u> found here.
- PE kit (this is brought in on a Monday, left on your child's peg in the cloakroom and then taken home on the weekend for a wash to be returned on Monday. This ensures that PE kit is always available if the timetable is tweaked. If your child attends after school club, they need to return their kit the following day please)
- Once they are given their reading book and planner (Years 2 6), this needs to be brought in every day.
- A smile, kindness and a willingness to learn!
